



### Gathering Around the Table

I shared how I believe that 70% of Jesus' ministry revolved around the table. Of course, the 70% is not an accurate number, but he sure spent most of his time eating and engaging with the people. People regularly invited Jesus to these meals, and sometimes, he even initiated a banquet, once by saying, "Zacchaeus, hurry down, for I must stay at your house today" (Luke 19:5). The table was

a sacred area where people not only shared their meal with one another but also shared their life. We also see how Jesus revealed himself to the disciples, on the road to Emmaus, during their meal.

When I first came to Raleigh Court United Methodist Church, I shared the culture shock of not having a meal after Sunday worship. I mentioned how I come from a church culture where we served lunch after every Sunday worship. I still am open to anyone who would like to share a Sunday meal with my family and me. We can go to Wendy's or Moe's Southwest Grill, where we can take advantage of the children eating free on Sundays.

The reason why I am sharing my thoughts about meals is because of the numbers of meals we are hosting at our church. In 2015, we had around four meals together throughout the year: Rally Day, Stewardship Sunday, Souper Bowl Sunday, and one other Sunday. Now we have approximately 45 meals year round. This includes our Mosaic and Open Table meals, and the Sundays we serve meals. These are only counting the meals we serve at church. If we add gatherings outside the church, like Know Your Neighbors, the rate skyrockets.

I wanted to thank everyone, who is behind the scenes making this all possible; people who prepare the meal, help clean up, and also the ones who organize these gatherings. Through your dedication, we see how God is working in our family of faith and making a transformation. I would also like to encourage our members to be a community of faith that invites others to the table, so that we can share our lives together. Remember what Jesus said, "where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them" (Matthew 18:20). Through our gatherings, we will see Jesus among us.





#### "All Are Welcome" Pageant Service




