Next classes February 5 & 12.

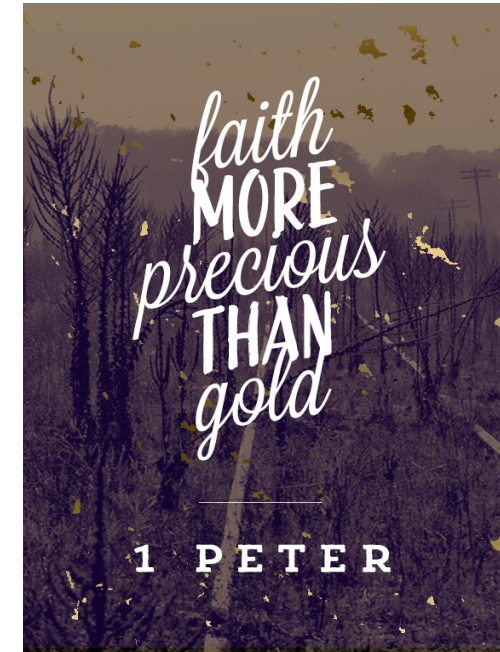

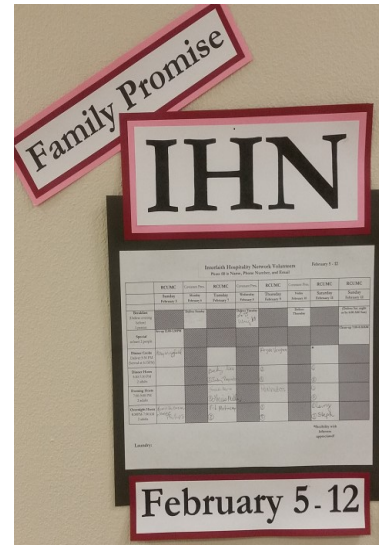
