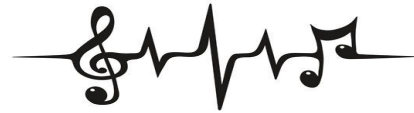

Debra LeBrun**

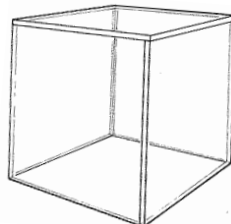
Today! June 18, 4:00 PM

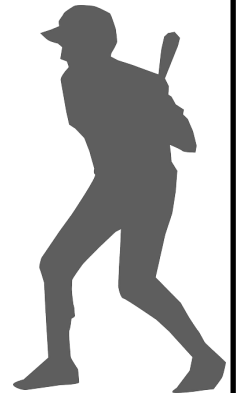
