A.C.T.S. is an easy way to remember key elements of prayer. It's simply prayer in four parts:

Adoration – "Praise be to God!" -Psalms 68:35 Tell God how much you appreciate Him. Express your love for Him. Praise His power and majesty.

Confession – "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just, and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." -1 John 1:9 Toll Him where you have fallen short. Be

Thanksgiving – Always "glorify him with thanksgiving" -Psalms 69:30


Thank God for His love, His faithfulness, His patience and a million other things. Express gratitude for what He's doing in your life.
