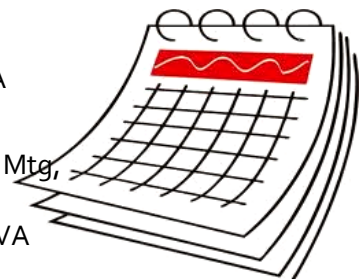


Reading Program

Chancel Choir – This group plays an important role as worship leaders each Sunday at our 11:00 worship service. After Thanksgiving our Chancel Choir is going to be travelling to New York City to sing in a concert at Carnegie Hall under the direction of composer Mark Hayes! We practice on Wednesdays at 7:30 – 9:00 and the group is open to adults and teens. We always are open to new members and we welcome both experienced singers and those who have never sung in a choir before! Rehearsals will begin with a special rehearsal on Thursday, Sept. 5th at 7:00 PM, so that we can practice with the First Light Worship Team for Rally Day.

Children's Choir and Ringers for the Lord– The Children's Choir is for children in Kindergarten through 5th grade. Children in 2nd-5th grade also ring handbells. We also have a Cherub Choir for preschool children that meets on Sunday mornings during the Sunday school time.

JuBELLation – This is our adult handbell choir. This group plays about once a month in church, in the Christmas Concert, and for other special events. Rehearsal is on Wednesdays at 6:45 – 7:45. Our first rehearsal will start at 6:30 so we can enjoy some social time, on **September 4**.

BELLievers – This handbell choir is for youth in grades 6 through 12. We play in church about once a month and in the Christmas Concert. We rehearse on Sundays at 5:30-6:30 prior to the Youth Ministry meeting. Rehearsals will begin on **September 15**.

First Light Worship Team - For our 8:30 worship service we are always looking for people interested in singing or playing an instrument with our worship team. Members of the Worship Team do not need to participate every week. Mark schedules the team on a week by week basis, based on team members' availability. 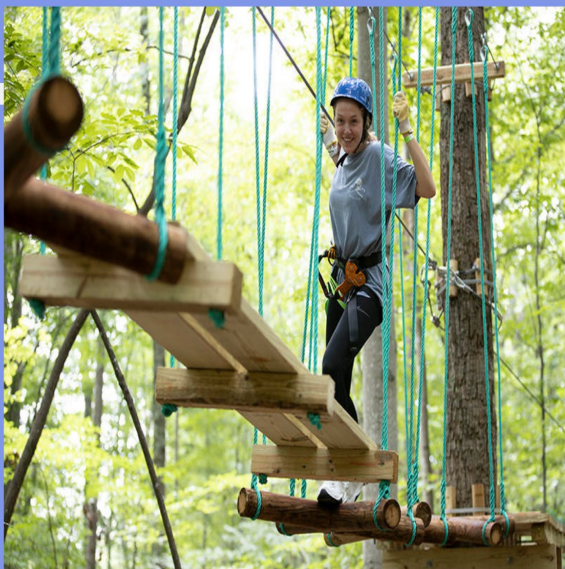
