
















On Saturday October 5th, the Raleigh Court United Methodist Men (and Nancy Carter) participated in the Renovation Alliance Veteran's Renovation Day. We were assigned a house that needed ceiling repair in the bedroom and handrail replacement from the sidewalk



to the house. We worked for a local veteran who can no longer do needed maintenance on his home and it was our opportunity to show our appreciation for his contribution to our country. The home owner is a young veteran who served terms in Iraq

and Afghanistan. He and his wife and two small children showed their appreciation to our teams and we shared a lunch with them on the front porch of the house.

In the bedroom, we removed two layers of sheetrock from the

ceiling that had been damaged by fire and moisture. The men made fast work of the demolition and clean up and then installed new sheetrock which was then taped and sealed for painting.





In the yard, a small crew that included Nancy dug holes for the new pipe handrail and after setting it in place, poured concrete to secure the pipe footings, then painted it to provide many years of use.

God was at work through our hands that

morning. Everyone pitched in and worked in unison moving debris from the room and returning with newly cut sheetrock. Without too much supervision, each person found a job to do and moved from one project need to another





and pitched in where need- ed. While the project had its inherent dangers, we all came away injury free. Well maybe some us woke up the next day with some aching joints and muscles, God's

reminder that we shared his love with others less fortunate.
